Funeral services for Frederick Edward Goeller, age 83 of Cullman, will be Wednesday, Feb. 6, 2013 at 1:00 pm at St. Paul's Lutheran Church with Pastor John Bussman officiating; interment will be in Cullman City Cemetery.
