Mr. Roberts passed away on Tuesday, Jul 23, 2024 at his daughter's home in Clanton. He was born in Ensley, near Birmingham, and was a graduate of Ensley High School. After high school, he worked for Cowan Construction, and was considered the go-to guy on the job. He then worked for the Jim Walter's #5 Coal Mine in Brookwood near Tuscaloosa for collectively 25 years. Lastly, he went to nursing school and worked as a RN.
