



John Morice Hasenbein

Memorial Service for John Morice Hasenbein, age 74, of Cullman, will be at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 1, 2019, at Christ Covenant Presbyterian Church.

Mr. Hasenbein passed away on Sunday, July 28, 2019, at Cullman Regional. He was born March 7, 1945, to John Maurice and Leona Hasenbein.

Mr. Hasenbein attended school at Sacred Heart, Saint Bernard Preparatory, and Cullman High School where he was a member of the 1962 State Championship Football Team. He majored in Business Administration and Economics at Saint Bernard College and received a master's degree from UAB in School Organization and Administration.

He served as the president of the Cullman County Teacher Association, chairman of the Alabama Education Association State Legislative committee for two years, president of the Cullman County Cattlemens Association for two years, board of directors for CCCA, thirty year board member for Alabama Feed & Grain Association and served as president for two terms during that time.

He taught school in Loretto, Tennessee and served as a football coach while there. He was a football coach and administrative assistant at Vinemont

School and assistant principal at West Point.

Mr. Hasenbein partnered with his best friend, Ronnie Donaldson, to form J & R Feed Service. Ronnie was more like a brother to him than a partner.

He was the purchasing manager for Alabama Farmers Cooperative feed division for ten years. He joined Bunge Corporation as the facility manager for nine years. He retired from the River Grain Operations in Decatur, Alabama.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

He is survived by his wife, Martha Ruth Hasenbein, who John said is "the best thing I ever did".
