His legacy will forever be remembered at Duck River Reservoir, where his dedication, hard work, and friendships left a lasting mark. His dedication to Cullman County was sincere. Tim instilled the values of integrity and hard work in everyone he met. He believed in work, hard work — the kind that ensured Zane could run the farm and Arleigh and Kadie could tend their gardens. Though he wore many hats throughout his life, his favorite was being an 'Auburn Dad'. He will be deeply missed, but his legacy will live on at Scott Farms and in the countless lives he touched.

He was preceded in death by his parents; uncle, James "Shorty" Scott; grandparents, James and Francis Heini Scott and Clyde and Kathryn Coker; father-in-law, Tommy Moses.
