helping others. He was constantly using Cullman Today as a platform to get the word out to help service organizations with their projects. He wanted to know how he could help others and how he could be a good friend.

Tim was a beloved father and husband and adored by many in the community. Although he was not from Cullman, he quickly became one of the community. He had a beautiful and unique way of seeing the world and a way of putting everyone he came in to contact with at ease immediately. He left the world a better place than he found it. Tim was loved by many and will be missed infinitely.
